The program provides companionship for veterans during their hospital stay.

Bill has served the Sons of The American Legion as Squadron Commander 1991-1992, Northern Central District SAL Commander 2001, Detachment Commander 2003. National Vice Commander Eastern Area 2003, Leading Candidate for National Commander 2004 and National Commander 2005-06.

Bill's accomplishments within the Legion Family are many from serving on every committee and commission at the squadron, district, detachment and national level of the Sons of The American Legion. His travels through the Legion family has serval great highlights. He served as the as the Chairmen of the National Member Training and Development Committee from 1997-2004. He was also instrumental in developing and revising the History and Scrap Book processes, to bring to life the Sons of The American Legion Consolidated Report Form during his year as National Commander 2005-06.

Bill has two Projects that are his special projects within his Legion career; The first was his successful involvement with (The Late) Past Department Commander, Douglas Johnson from Parkville Post 183 in the establishment of the Maryland Homeless Veterans Center (Now called The Maryland Center for Veterans Education and Training McVets). He served as a member of Board of Director since 1993 thru 2013 and as Vice President 2011 thru 2013.

The Casey Cares Foundation was Bills second successful program within the Detachment of Maryland, Sons of The American Legion. During his year as SAL, NCD Commander he developed the relationship between the Sons and The Casey Cares Foundation to life as his district commanders project. When he earned the opportunity to be the Detachment Commander in 2003 the Casey Cares Foundation again became his project. Thanks to the detachment members in 2003 they raffled off an automobile with all the proceeds going to Casey Cares. Today, The Casey Cares Foundation is still a major program supported by The Sons of The American Legion. We have been afforded a place on their board of directors in 2005 and continue at that level of involvement today.


