Dear SAL Members of the Bernard L. Tobin Post 128. As of the last meeting of the SAL Squadron 128, the following actions occurred:

Old Business

Membership: SAL Squadron 128 has currently 53 paid members. Target goal is 180; therefore, 127 more are needed.

Proposals for renewal of memberships. Send out post cards to those members who were members in 2018. Do not go back to those whose last membership was 2017. Determine the cost of printing post cards and labels. Will check stores such as Office Depot, Staples, etc. and others for prices. (Office Depot gave an estimate of \$0.15/card not including labels. Reconsidered having Boy Scout Troop print labels on post cards.

SAL Scholarship. #3rd Vice Commander of the NCD, Mark P. (forget last name) stated at the SAL NCD Meeting in Bel Air that the District is looking to have a scholarship as well of approximately \$3,000.00. Squadron 128 was considering a \$500.00 scholarship for a needy SAL member. SAL 128 concerns arose when it was stated that the scholarship would go to a Boy's State attendee. This was a requirement by NCD. This was tabled for further discuss amongst Squadron 128 members.

Community Service. Still looking into providing Community Service by having the Squadron sign up to "Adopt a Road". The road would be Route 22 between Carsin's Run Rd and 95, both sides. This is approximately a mile. Contact will be made with the County to determine what is necessary.

New Business

Bob Reid was approved as the Sgt. of Arms for SAL Squadron 128.

3rd Vice NCD Mark P. left a stack of Raffle Tickets for a 19 Oz. Pechauer Cue/Case (valued at \$425.00). Tickets are \$1.00 a piece or 6 for \$5.00. I will bring these to the Post to give to you or Bobby Hanson. The drawing is February 24, 2019 and will take place at the NCD Pool Tournament.

3rd Vice NCD Mark P. also left a stack of raffle tickets for the Detachment of Maryland supporting the Special Olympics. The tickets are \$1.00 apiece. First Prize is \$500.00 and 2nd Prize is \$250.00. I will drop these off at the Post sometime this week.

Will be contacting the State Highway Commission to get permission to "Adopt a Road" for cleanup. This will be SAL's commitment to the community. The area of interest is from Carsin's Run Road to Rt. 95 and back. Waiting for response.
